This included everything from hats, aprons, dresses, shoes, suits, uniforms, childrens clothes and undergarments. It was the one area in the museum that has not been touched yet. After 3 weeks of sorting and checking paperwork we finally know what is what. The majority of items will be photographed, wrapped and stored for future use, but a few have made it out onto the museum floor.
